TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The filing of this Application does not automatically guarantee that a permit will be issued,
2. The Applicant/Sponsor shall be responsible for any violations of the Town of Columbus Ordinances, State and Federal law, in regards to the use of this permit should the permit be granted,
3. The date of filing this application is not less than 15 business days nor more than 30 business days, in advance of the anticipated event,
4. In determining whether to grant a permit, the Town Manager shall consider:
 - a. The time period during which the event will occur;
 - b. The location of the event;
 - c. Whether the activities would be in compliance with other applicable laws;
 - d. Whether the designated place at the requested time has already been permitted to a different applicant
 - e. Whether the equipment to be used and the number of units of equipment to be used will likely lead to excessive noise;
 - f. Whether the Applicant/Sponsor has had any prior violations of the Town of Columbus noise ordinance or related state or federal law violations;
 - g. Whether this Applicant/Sponsor has had prior permits granted which excluded the opportunity to provide permits to neighboring property, and whether in the interest of fairness and equity, a neighboring property should be given a permit
5. The issuance of a permit to a sponsor shall authorize only that sponsor and participants specifically authorized by the sponsor to participate in that event.
6. The issuance of this permit does not negate your responsibility to comply with all ordinances of the Town of Columbus, including, but not limited to noise violations, as well as all other State and Federal laws, and your failure to comply with the same could result in criminal process separate and apart from the administrative penalties set forth herein.
7. Sponsor's failure to comply with applicable Town ordinances, state and federal law, in regards to the event contemplated in this permit application, may result in the denial of future permits, the suspension of the applicant's ability to request a similar permit for a set period of time, the immediate cessation of use of amplification equipment, fines of \$500.00, as well as criminal charges or civil penalties.
8. Sponsor's false or misleading information provided in this application may result in the denial of future permits, the suspension of the sponsor's ability to request a similar permit for a set period of time, and/or the immediate revocation of any permit granted as a result of this application.
9. In issuing the permit, the manager for the Town of Columbus may provide conditions for the use of the permit, (including, but not limited to, a set decibel limit on noise) and any failure of the Sponsor to abide by (or ensure other participants abide by the same) may result in the denial of future permits, the suspension of the sponsor's ability to request a similar permit for a set period of time, and/or the immediate revocation of any permit granted as a result of this application.
